

# CASE STUDY

## NOSSAL HIGH SCHOOL



**Client Name:** Nossal High School

**The Brief:** Nossal High School is Victoria's first fully academically selective coeducational Government High School, and one of only four academically selective high schools in Victoria opened in February 2010 and the final building work were completed in early 2012. Nossal High School approached Save Time Visuals to deliver and implement a dynamic audio visual and digital signage solution specifically for the new school classrooms, gym, foyer, theatre, performing arts and music room.

**The Solution:** A COMMBOX DVC Digital Signage Server with 5x Media Retrievers was commissioned onto the existing school network. The DVC Server includes two Digital Tuner Cards allowing the transmission free to air TV, Foxtel or in house DVD to the five display screens.

The day to day bulletins, important dates, assessment calendar and other updates are handled by the customized web application developed by Aaron Houghton (ICT). This system integrates with their intranet (Sharepoint) and Learning Management system allowing virtually a self-managed solution to retrieve information from other areas on the network with ease.

The Media Retrievers are compatible with Samsung Commercial LCD Displays which are backed by a 3year On-Site Warranty. This gives Nossal High School the confidence in the reliability and functionality of the equipment and the system they invested in.

**The Result:** The streamlined network of digital integration allows the teachers and the Administration staff to easily post the bulletins, important dates and information, updating the students on the up-coming events, keep them engaged and informed. Mostly importantly, it requires a low level of administration from the IT Department to maintain the system.
