The Brief: Upwey contacted Save Time Visuals looking for a digital signage/display screen system around the school. After numerous discussions, meetings and site visits, it was decided that the ability to record, store and distribute learning resources using the same system would streamline operations, and allow the college to build their content library for free - replacing their existing Clickview System.

The Solution: A full 12 terrabyte DVC Enterprise Server was installed, along with 8 dedicated Digital Signage players on their existing screens. Each screen was equipped with a media controller, to process the Digital Signage Presentation. Once the Active Directory Integration had been done, and staff trained to use the system, Upwey HS was ready to continue building their digital content library.

The Result: A streamlined system enabling teaching staff to access content wherever they may be within the college, inspiring students with motivational scrolling messages on the Digital Signage Screens, and occasionally watching cricket in the staff room.
